Hratch Tchilingirian is an analyst of the Caucasus region and a researcher in sociology. Currently, he is a doctoral candidate in the Sociology Department at the London School of Economics and Political Science, University of London, researching former Soviet autonomies, such as Nagorny (Mountainous) Karabakh, Abkhazia, South Ossetia and other unresolved conflicts in the South Caucasus. Tchilingirian received a Master of Divinity degree from St. Vladimir's Theological School, a Diploma in Armenian Church Studies from St. Nersess Armenian Seminary in New York, and a Master of Public Administration from California State University, Northridge. He was the Dean of St. Nersess Seminary from 1991 to 1994. Tchilingirian was also co-founder and editor of *Window View of the Armenian Church*, a quarterly magazine dealing with issues in the Armenian Church (1990-1995) and a Senior Editor of *Armenian International Magazine* (1998-February 2001). Since 1994, his analyses and articles on contemporary Armenian affairs in Armenia, Karabakh and the Diaspora have appeared in publications in the United States, Europe and the Middle East.
